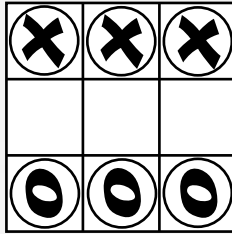


Time Trip Travels 'The Egyptians'

The Seega Board Setup



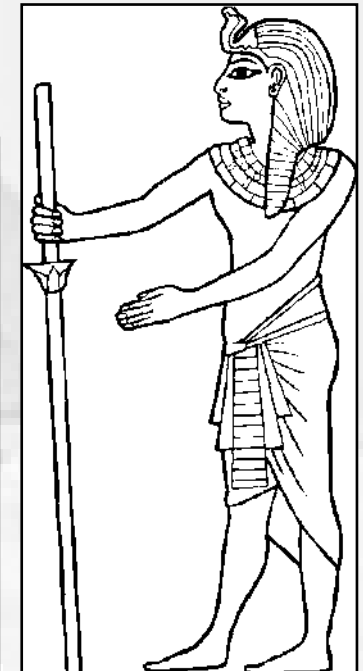
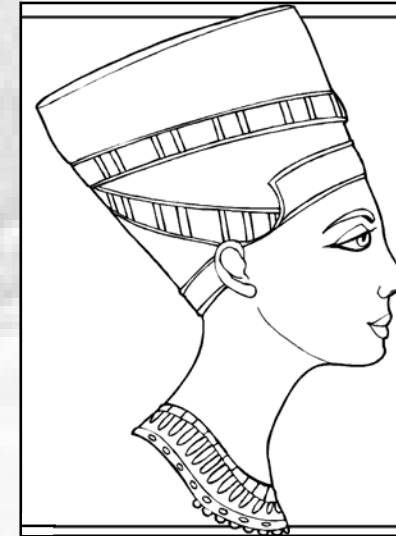
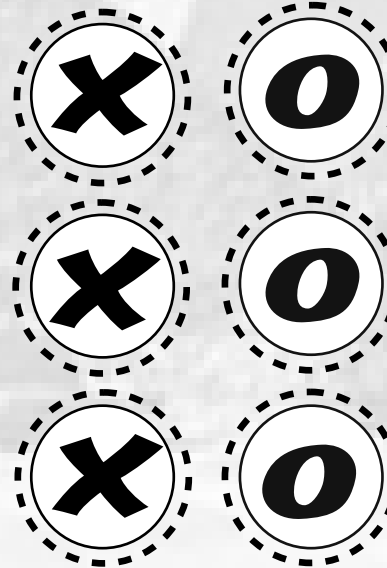
DID YOU KNOW?

The Rules of Seega

Players take it in turns to move 1 of their pieces either 1 or 2 squares on the board. Players can move in any direction but cannot pass over another piece. The winner of the game is the first player to get their 3 pieces in a straight line (diagonal included) other than the starting line.
